

#### Spiritual Development Update from Sheila Enstine

#### **Important Dates for January 2024:**

The Christmas Season or Christmastide began on Christmas Eve and continues until Epiphany on January 6<sup>th</sup>. The Liturgical color during Christmastide is white, symbolizing purity.

Epiphany Sunday is commonly celebrated on the Sunday after the 6<sup>th</sup>, which is January 7<sup>th</sup> in 2024. Epiphany means manifestation and it celebrates the revelation of Jesus Christ as the Light of the World. Three narratives from the Gospels are read during this season. They are: the visit of the Magi or Wise Men from the East; Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist; and Jesus' first miracle – the changing of water into wine at the wedding in Cana of Galilee. The season after Epiphany lasts until the beginning of Lent on Ash Wednesday, February 14<sup>th</sup> this year. The Liturgical color for the Epiphany Season is green.

#### Adult Small Groups:

**The Sunday morning group** is studying the Gospel of Mark. The class meets on Sundays at 8:45 am. Let Sheila Enstine know if you're interested.

The Wednesday night Praise and Fellowship gathers at 7 pm with the praise team. After worship, we have a time of fellowship and prayer.

The Thursday evening Bible Study begins at 7 pm. Pastor Ed is leading a study on the Gospel of Matthew. The Friday afternoon Women's Bible Study is on break until Lent.

Nursery: The nursery is available every Sunday for babies and children through age five.

<u>Children's Church:</u> After the first set of worship music on Sundays, children ages 6 through 10 (about 5<sup>th</sup> grade) are welcome to attend Children's Church


